We are pleased to submit this letter to demonstrate our commitment to matching funds for the North Avenue Corridor Improvements Project. The Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) eligible portion of the project is estimated to cost \$25,012,500, out of which the City of Chicago is requesting \$20,010,000 from the SS4A program. This project is supported by numerous agencies and organizations, and the City of Chicago is fully committed to its construction.

The purpose of this letter is to confirm the City of Chicago's commitment to funding the required \$5,002,500 of matching funds with non-federal funds. Additionally, the City of Chicago commits to funding the remainder of the project costs through other funding sources upon award of the SS4A funding. Also, as a sign of our commitment to this project, the Chicago Department of Transportation is completing preliminary and design engineering with non-federal funding.
